APPLICATION FOR CONVICTION REVIEW

The Conviction Integrity Unit of the Amador County District Attorney's Office investigates claims of *actual* innocence exclusively and retains complete discretion to deny an application for conviction review. The Conviction Integrity Unit will not consider requests for resentencing.

Requirements: In order to qualify for a conviction review by the Amador County District Attorney's Office, the case and applicant must meet the following criteria:

- a. The conviction must have occurred in Amador County Superior Court;
- b. Applicant must be in custody, serving time on the sentence for which he/she was wrongfully convicted;
- c. The conviction must be for a violent and/or serious felony as defined by Penal Code sections 667.5 (c) and 1192.7 (c) (1)-(42) (e.g. murder, rape, robbery, etc.);
- d. The application for review must be based on credible and verifiable evidence of innocence; and
- e. Applicant agrees to fully cooperate with the District Attorney's Office, which includes providing disclosure of all relevant information during the review process.
